

Sarcee Trail & Richmond Road intersection improvements

Construction Notice

The construction contract has been awarded for the Sarcee Trail & Richmond Road intersection improvements project and we are preparing to transition to the construction phase. **Work is scheduled to begin the week of July 6, 2020.** Here's what to expect:

What improvements are being completed as part of this project?

The project includes a number of upgrades to help improve traffic flow as well as the safety and experience of pedestrians and cyclists. This includes:

- Widening the existing pathway at the intersection of Richmond Road and Sarcee Trail S.W.
- Adding one northbound and one southbound lane on Sarcee Tr. between Optimist Park and the Transportation Utility corridor
- Improving traffic signal timing at the intersection of Richmond Road and Sarcee Trail S.W.

What construction activities will be taking place in the area?

Work is scheduled to begin at the intersection of Sarcee Trail and Richmond Road S.W., and extend north to 26 Ave. S.W. and south to the Transportation Utility Corridor throughout construction. Main construction activities will include:

- Widening of Sarcee Trail to provide one additional northbound and one additional southbound lane between Optimist Park and the Transportation Utility corridor
- Widening existing pathways along the south and north sides of the intersection.
- Relocation and timing improvements of traffic signals at the intersection
- Construction of LED street lighting in the project area

Alternating lane closures will be required to complete this work.

Access to area businesses will remain open throughout construction.

How will I be notified of upcoming construction and detours?

Construction signage will be posted near the work zones in the project area. This signage will provide advance notice of any required lane closures and detours for vehicles, pedestrians and cyclists. Information can also be found online at calgary.ca/sarcee.

When will this work be taking place?

Construction is set to begin the week of July 6, 2020 and will be complete in Fall 2020.
